BEDFORD MUSEUM TO HOST DREAMCATCHERS WORKSHOP FOR KIDS

Bedford – The Southern Alleghenies Museum of Art at Bedford is offering a dreamcatchers workshop for children. In this informative and creative Southwestern art workshop, children will have an opportunity to create their very own dreamcatcher. Students will take a journey through the spiritual meaning behind dreamcatchers and discover what they symbolize. Children also will learn about the ancient art form of pottery and will handcraft their very own piece of pottery.

The workshop, led by Bedford artist and SAMA trustee Nicole Clark, is scheduled for 9:30 a.m. to noon on Saturday, November 3 and is designed for ages 6 to 11.
