### **SAMA-LORETTO TO HOST NEEDLE FELTING CLASS**

Loretto – The Southern Alleghenies Museum of Art at Loretto will host a needle felting class from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Saturday, October 20. Kathleen Krestar, an art teacher with Forest Hills School District, will lead the class as participants create needle felted sculptures. The class is designed for adults and children ages 10 and older. Cost for the class is \$30 per person. Materials will be provided but guests are encouraged to pack a lunch.

Needle felting is a process that uses barbed needles to interlock wool fibers to form a more condensed material. Wool fibers have scales which, when rubbed against each other, catch and lock into place to create a denser material called felt. Felting needles are used to entangle the fibers. The SAMA workshop will also include a presentation on tips for properly cleaning and carding wool.

The Southern Alleghenies Museum of Art at Loretto is located on the campus of Saint Francis University. Hours of operation are 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Tuesday through Friday and 1 to 5 p.m. Saturday.
