SAMA TO OFFER MARBLED SILK SCARF WORKSHOP

Ligonier – The Southern Alleghenies Museum of Art at Ligonier Valley will offer a “Marbled Silk Scarf” workshop from 11 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Saturday, April 7. Marbled silk scarves are known for their color and beauty, and new art supplies have made the process quick and easy. Artists Jean Coursey Beaufort and Patricia Jones will demonstrate the marbling process, and then lead participants in the creation of their very own marbled silk scarf. The scarves are white, hemmed, and measure 11” x 60”.

Cost for the class is \$25, which includes all supplies. Class size is limited, and reservations are suggested by calling the Museum at (724) 238-6015. The marbling process takes only about 15 to 20 minutes, though participants are invited to stay as others create their own scarves.

The Southern Alleghenies Museum of Art at Ligonier Valley is located at One Boucher Lane and Route 711 South in Ligonier.
