SAMA-ALTOONA TO HOST *WICKED WEDNESDAY*

Altoona – The Southern Alleghenies Museum of Art at Altoona will host another installment of its popular *Wicked Wednesday* series on June 28. The program offers the region’s best musical, culinary and fine arts in one setting. *Wicked Wednesday* includes light supper and libations while guests listen to some of the area’s finest musical talent. Each program also highlights the Museum’s latest exhibitions.

The June 28 program will include a performance by The Amigos. Guests also will have an opportunity to view the Museum’s current exhibitions. *Tim Boyles: Celebrity Status* offers more than 80 celebrity photographs by the Altoona native. In *Kim Williams: View to the Soul*, guests will find 86 of the artist’s realistic paintings that explore the expressiveness of animals’ eyes through both whimsy and thoughtful messaging. Also on view is *William H. Rau: Openings – Urban, Rural, Rail*, which chronicles the landscape of photography of Rau, who was the official photographer of the Pennsylvania Railroad at the turn of the 20th century.
