SAMA-ALTOONA TO HOST *WICKED WEDNESDAY*

Altoona – The Southern Alleghenies Museum of Art at Altoona’s 2017 *Wicked Wednesday* season will conclude on November 15. The program offers the region’s best musical, culinary and fine arts in one setting. *Wicked Wednesday* includes light supper and libations while guests listen to some of the area’s finest musical talent. Each program also highlights the Museum’s latest exhibitions.

The November program will include acoustic music by Ed O’Brien and Bruce Schettig. Guests also will have an opportunity to view the Museum’s current exhibitions, *Deb Bunnell: Relatives and Other Stories* and *Artists in Our Midst: Art in Common Annual Juried Exhibition*. Using family photos for reference, Bunnell paints memories that she associates with strong emotions. Thirty-five paintings and drawings, mostly in acrylic or colored pencil, are on display. *Artists in Our Midst* features nearly 70 works in a variety of media by local artists in this annual exhibition by Art in Common members.
