SAMA receives highest honor in 2023 "Year of Service"

Reaccreditation is a process that takes several years, where every aspect of the museum's operations, scholarship and conservation efforts is analyzed and evaluated. Of the United States' estimated 33.000 museums, only 1,099 have earned the standing of currently accredited. In Pennsylvania alone, there are only 35 institutions with this achievement. On November 22, 2022, the American Alliance of

Museums (AAM), the only organization representing the entire scope of the museum community, announced the Southern Alleghenies Museum of Art has earned reaccreditation.

Over the past two years, SAMA's staff and Board of Trustees have worked with AAM to present the museum's strategic plan, operating procedures, and hundreds of pages worth of reports. The Commission

Education Update

The Museum/Healthcare Partnership (MHP) and Artist-In-Residence (AIR) programs are going strong.

MHP residencies are designed to help area residents suffering from mental or physical conditions. Currently, we have a residency planned with UPMC in Somerset County at Twin Lakes Treatment Center with teaching artist, Evgeny Krayushkin. We also have a residency with Bethlen Communities in Westmoreland County. Teaching Artist, Rita Haldeman, will be facilitating that residency. In late spring 2023, SAMA Loretto will be displaying a special, "Arts for Healing" exhibition from a residency completed by Evgeny during a residency with Conemaugh Hospital.

There are two very special AIR residencies this year. We are highlighting our "Art Sparks" Residencies with two Bedford school districts. The Pennsylvania Council on the Arts in collaboration with the Pennsylvania Turnpike has offered these very special programs to schools near the turnpike. With the support from SAMA teaching artists, these residencies have blossomed into fantastic murals which guests will enjoy for years to come.

This year, Everett Area School District and Chestnut Ridge School District are participating in this exciting opportunity. Each school has teaching artist. Bob Zabrosky, visiting. The students from each district are creating a special mural which displays their distinct venues and important locations from their region in the county. It also highlights their school spirit. Once completed, these murals will be placed at the Turnpike plazas located in Bedford county for visitors to view for many years to come. A special unveiling will be celebrated in late spring for both districts.

ARTISTS OF THE 21st CENTURY

SAMA celebrates the area's talented young artists with the Museum's twenty-fifth annual student art exhibition.



All three galleries at Altoona showcase student artwork for the first time.

The exhibition is open to schools that participate in SAMA's Arts-in-Education or Artistin-Residence program. Each district is permitted to submit up to 25 individual projects and two group projects. Through the programs, SAMA educators and professional artists travel to public and parochial schools to provide lessons designed to enhance students' understanding of art creation, technique, history, critique, and aesthetics. SAMA's award-winning education initiative is the largest of its kind in the Commonwealth. Artworks from the SAMA Education Collection that are used by the teaching artists in the Arts-in-Education program to educate students in a school setting accompany and supplement the exhibition.

This year was a first for Altoona who hosted the student artwork on behalf of Loretto which was closed for renovations. At Altoona, you wil find student artwork from schools in Blair, Somerset, and Cambria counties. Bedford displays student artwork from the Bedford County Schools, and Ligonier Valley showcases student artwork from schools in Fayette and Westmoreland counties.

The exhibition will be displayed at Altoona until April 16, 2023, Bedford until April 23, 2023, and Ligonier until April 30, 2023. This exhibition is sponsored by the Sigma Chapter of Alpha Delta Kappa International Honorary Organization for Women Educators and the Jack Buncher Foundation.

This project was made possible through the AIE Partnership of the Pennsylvania Council on the Arts, a state agency.

Our staff and trustees did an amazing job getting the word out and selling raffle tickets to friends, family, and visitors of SAMA.


